 - For example: If rent = \$1250, income must = \$3750/mo.

Helpful Housing Information

WAIT LISTS

- **Affordable properties generally require 2x rent in income to qualify**
 - SNAP may considered income for some properties
- **Pinehurst Properties** - Wait lists open and close
 - Waitlist status updated on individual websites (see previous page)
- **Viridian Properties (Vrd.) & Guardian Real Estate Services (GRES)**- Waitlists are ALWAYS open
 - Apply online at www.viridianmgt.com | properties.gres.com
- **Other properties not listed:** Contact Thrive for more information

HOUSING VOUCHER

- **Housing Works** holds a lottery each year, usually Monday- Friday during the 2nd week of January. *This is the only time you can apply for the program.*
- **You must apply online during that week**
 - **ONLY** at www.housing-works.org
 - If you need assistance with the application process, please contact Thrive
- **The number of vouchers** changes every year
- If you are not selected, your application does not roll over to the next year, you **MUST** reapply the following January!

RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- **NeighborImpact Programs & Thrive Central Oregon Programs** : Funding cycles may vary, the following programs may or may not have funding when you need it.
